This Addendum No. 2 is issued and hereby published on the DGS website on April 23, 2013. Except as modified hereby, the Request for Proposal (RFP) remains unmodified.

**Item#1**

Section A.1 FORM OF CONTRACT

**Delete:** The Form of Contract will be issued by addendum. Offeror(s) should carefully review the Form of Contract when submitting their proposal. To the extent there are any inconsistencies between this RFP and the Form of Contract, the Form of Contract shall prevail. Offeror(s) are further advised that they are required to submit their proposal premised upon entering into a contract that is substantially similar to the Form of Contract and that any proposed changes to the Form of Contract must be clearly identified and described in their proposal. A proposal that fails to specifically identify and describe the requested changes shall be deemed non-responsive.

**Insert:** The Form of Contract will be issued at the time of contract award.

**Item #2**

Section A.2 CONTRACTOR'S COMPENSATION

**Delete:** The Contractor will be awarded a fixed unit price contract. The unit prices will be the Contractor's sole method of compensation and as such shall be adequate to cover all of the Contractor's costs associated with the delivery of the required services. In the event that the District adds additional locations, the Contractor will be paid the fixed unit collection prices contained in **Attachment B**.

**Insert:** The Contractor will be awarded a fixed unit price contract with a cost reimbursement component. The Contractor will be paid the fixed unit prices contained on **Attachment B** for collection of the recycling material and will be reimbursed the actual cost incurred for the **Recovery Fees**.

The Contractor's fixed unit prices for the collection of recycling materials and the cost reimbursement component for the Recovery Fee will be the Contractor's sole compensation and as such shall be adequate to cover all of the Contractor's costs associated with the delivery of the required services.

The cost reimbursement ceiling for this contract is set forth in **Attachment B**. The cost reimbursement ceiling shall remain the same unless modified in writing by the Contracting Officer.

***Questions and Answers***

**Question #1:** In light of the cancellation of the Trash Collection RFP, has a determination been made as to whether or not to go forward with the Recycling Collection RFP?

**Answer:** Yes, DGS is continuing with the solicitation of DCAM-13-NC-0137 Recycling Collection Services. **Item #22** extends the closing date for this solicitation to May 1, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.

**Question #2:** Based on the set price in the contract we would like to know, what facility gave the prices (\$31.59) for dumping? We have contacted Rodgers Bros. and World Recycling, neither of whom will accept the recyclables for this price. We also attempted to contact Waste Management and they have not returned our calls.

**Answer:** The amount of the Processing Fee (per ton) has been deleted on the revised Unit Price Spreadsheet, see **Item #18**.

**Question #3:** Will this vendor accept recyclables from all bidders at the stated price?

**Answer:** This question is no longer applicable, see response to **Question #2**.

**Question #4:** What is the estimated tonnage for this contract?

**Answer:** The estimated tonnage for this contract is 618 tons.

**Question #5:** 300 Indiana Ave., in Group 4 is listed as Front End service, but with totters, is this correct?

**Answer:** No, 300 Indiana Ave., in Group 4 (page 5) has been deleted from the list of Service Locations (Attachment A), see **Item #16**. Also note that this location has height restrictions.

**Question #6:** 1901 D Street, CDF, is listed on Group 5 but should be in Group 4, is this correct?

**Answer:** No, 1901 D Street, CDF, will remain listed on Group 5.

**Question #7:** Section B.1.1.3.3 (f) calls for wraps on dumpsters; who will design the wraps? Who will approve the design? Can the wraps be put on after placement?

**Answer:** The wraps will be designed by the Contractor, but the DGS appointed COTR can be contacted for assistance and/or input. The design will be approved by the DGS appointed COTR. Yes, the wraps can be put on after placement.

**Question #8:** Section B.1.1.3.1 (e) can side doors be installed without hinges?

**Answer:** Yes, side doors can be installed without hinges if they are secured and approved by the DGS appointed COTR.

**Question #9:** Section B.1.1.3.1 (f) calls for recycling dumpsters to be blue, who has approval of the shade of blue?

**Answer:** The shade of blue is the industry shade of blue used for all standard recycling containers. The COTR must approve the proposed shade of blue.

**Question #10:** Section B.1.1.3.2 (f) calls for 12 inch wheels, is there a reason 10" wheels are unacceptable?

**Answer:** 10 inch wheels are acceptable.

**Question #11:** Is section B.1.1.3.4 not applicable for this RFP?

**Answer:** Yes, Section B.1.1.3.4 is applicable for this RFP, because it may apply to additional service request(s) that may arise as a result of service changes.

**Question #12:** Is section B.1.1.3.5 not applicable for this RFP?

**Answer:** Yes, Section B.1.1.3.5 is applicable for this RFP, Recycling Collection Services DCAM-13-NC-0137 because it may apply to additional service request(s) that may arise as a result of service changes.

**Question #13:** Do you anticipate time restrictions on servicing schools?

**Answer:** Yes, no pick-ups can be made before 7:00 a.m. or after 7:00 p.m.

**Question #14:** In the event the weight of a front-end truck damages playgrounds or parking lots, due to weight beyond what the surface is designed for, whose responsibility will it be? Has the contracting officer considered allowing rear-load trucks to service 4 or 6 yard dumpsters multiple times?

**Answer:** In the event the weight of a front-end truck damages playgrounds or parking lots, due to weight beyond what the surface is designed for, the Contractor shall repair or replace District property. Yes, the contracting officer has considered allowing rear-load trucks to service 4 or 6 yard dumpsters multiple times, but has determined that multiple service trips to the same location is not efficient or in the best interest of the District.

**Question #15:** The RFP requires “Professional Liability” coverage (insurance), what professional liability are they anticipating? Professional liability coverage usually refers to lawyers, architects, engineers etc.

**Answer:** This question is no longer applicable, see **Item #16**

**Question #16:** Regarding “Vacation” and “Health and Welfare” requirements of the DOL regulations, does the District’s requirement for sick leave apply in addition to the DOL requirements or can the costs of the District’s “Sick Leave” requirement be applied against the DOL “Health and Welfare” costs?

**Answer:** The Contractor and its sub-contractors are required to only follow Department of Labor regulations regarding Service Contract Act wage rates.

**Question #17:** Will Offeror’s be required to be a licensed “Solid Waste Collector” in the District of Columbia? Will Offeror’s be required to be a “registered recycler” in the District of Columbia?

**Answer:** Licensure as a Solid Waste Collector is not applicable to this solicitation. Selected Contractors must, however, be certified by the Department of Public Works, Office of Recycling as a “Registered Recycler.” For more detailed can be obtained by contacting the DPW Office of Recycling at 202.645.8245 or

**Question #18:** While DPW does not have an MRF, will DGS allow the contractor to utilize its transfer station capability to approved MRFs?

**Question #19:** Is it acceptable to deliver the organics recycling to the DPW Organics Transfer facility?

**Answer:** Yes, it is acceptable to deliver the organics recycling to the DPW Organics Recovery Facility.

**Question #20:** The RFP requires an original and six (6) copies, is this for each aggregate group?

**Answer:** Yes, The RFP requires an original and six (6) copies of the technical proposal only.

**Question #21:** Section B1.1.3.6, requires the Contractor to have all three systems, routing, AVL/GPS, and Rfid?

**Answer:** All three (3) systems are required, routing, AVL/GPS and Rfid.

**Question #22:** Is it required that they be integrated? If so, does the District know of a single integrated system?

**Answer:** No, they are not required to be integrated.

**Question #23:** The Recycling Collection Services bid is actually due on Wednesday, the 24<sup>th</sup> as stated on the website, not Tuesday, and the 23<sup>rd</sup> as printed on the cover page of the RFP?

**Answer:** The Recycling Collection Services Solicitation, DCAM-13-NC 0137 has been extended, to May 1, 2013 at 2:00 p.m.

**Question #24:** In your Recycling Collection Contract there is a yearly de-escalating rebate to the District Government for the recyclables collected. In anticipation that recycling will increase and trash collection will decrease as a result of recycling education can a provision be put in the contract that will decrease the number of pick-ups per week and then provide funding for recycling education.
