You can be arrested if you smoke or consume marijuana in public, have more than 1 ounce, or sell any amount of marijuana. Driving while under the influence of marijuana is a dangerous crime and will be prosecuted.

Under federal law, federal law enforcement officers may arrest anyone in the District for possession of any amount of marijuana.
