DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

On Monday, December 15, 1986 at approximately 9:15 AM, **Dr. Clifton Fleming Brown** was found fatally stabbed in his apartment in the 2600 block of 16th Street, NW. Dr. Brown was a professor of history at Howard University at the time of his death. The Metropolitan Police Department seeks the public's assistance in gathering information regarding this homicide.
