**DESCRIPTION**

At approximately 12:05 am, on Saturday, August 12, 2006, police were called to the 1400 block of Fairmont Street, NW, to investigate the trouble. Upon arrival officers located 25-year-old **Terran Miller**, of the 1400 block of Fairmont Street, NW, suffering from apparent severe head injuries. The preliminary investigation indicates that he was shot at by a person or persons unknown while in the 1400 block of Fairmont Street, NW. While fleeing he was struck by a car that failed to stop. He was taken to the Washington Hospital Center's MedStar Unit and admitted in critical condition. At approximately 8:05 am, on Friday, August 18, 2006, Terran Miller was pronounced dead as a result of his injuries.

The case is under investigation by members of the Department's Violent Crimes Branch.
