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## **DEFINITIONS**

**BUILDING** -Any structure, whether temporary or permanent, built to support, shelter or enclosure of persons, or property of any kind.

**COLLECTION PRICE** -The collection price is the Contractor's bid price for conducting a pick-up of a single trash container. This price includes the total price, including profit, for providing all containers, equipment, personnel, facilities, and support necessary to provide the container, pick-up a single container, and transport the collected to a material recovery facility or end-user (market). This price does not include the disposal/tipping fee.

**COLLECTION SERVICE**- Applies to recyclable materials collection, construction and demolition (C&D) collections, and compostable materials at the sole direction of DGS.

**COLLECTOR** -Any person, employed by the Contractor or a subcontractor, who is engaged in the collection or transportation of recyclable, compostable, or salvages materials. An individual deemed able to perform requirements under the Agreement who has undergone drug or alcohol testing as a condition of his/her employer, possesses a current and in good standing Commercial Driver License, as well as applicable experience driving and operating a front-end/rear-end load vehicle or similar.

**CONTRACTOR** - A commercially-operated company or entity engaged by the District to perform collection, transport, and disposition and/or processing of recyclable materials at points located in the District and Maryland. All Entities and their subcontractors are to be registered with the DC Public Works Department.

**DEDICATED VEHICLES** – refers to set aside vehicles (i.e. packer trucks, lift gate truck, etc.) on set routes exclusively servicing District government facilities.

**FISCAL YEAR**- Period from October 1 of each year and ending on September 30 of the subsequent year.

**ILLEGAL DUMPING** – for purposes of this solicitation illegal dumping refers to unwanted garbage (i.e. white goods, mattresses, broken furniture, wooden pallets, etc.)

**MISSED COLLECTIONS** -A missed collection is defined as the failure by the Contractor to provide a collection service pickup at a previously scheduled location during the course of that business day.

**TRASH TRANSFER STATION OR DISPOSAL FACILITY** - are facilities where municipal solid waste is unloaded from collection vehicles and briefly held while it is reloaded onto larger long-distance transport vehicles for shipment to landfills or other treatment or disposal facilities.

DISPOSAL FEE – is a per ton waste management fee collected by state local government at transfer station.

TRASH - also known as rubbish, refuse, garbage, junk, and litter.
