<b>DFZ AREA:</b>	U St NW & 9th St NW		<b>POLICE DISTRICT:</b>	3 <sup>rd</sup>
<b>BOUNDARIES:</b>	The northwest corner of the zone at the intersection of V St NW and 9th St NW, proceed east along V St NW to the intersection of V St NW and 8th St NW. At the intersection of V St NW and 8th St NW, proceed south along 8th St NW to the intersection of T St NW and 8th St NW. At the intersection of T St NW and 8th St NW, proceed west along T St NW to the intersection of Vermont Ave NW and T St NW. At the intersection of Vermont Ave NW and T St NW, proceed northeast along Vermont Ave NW to the intersection of Vermont Ave NW and U St NW. At the intersection of Vermont Ave NW and U St NW, proceed east along U St NW to the intersection of U St NW and 9th St NW. At the intersection of U St NW and 9th St NW, proceed north along 9th St NW, finally returning to the starting point.

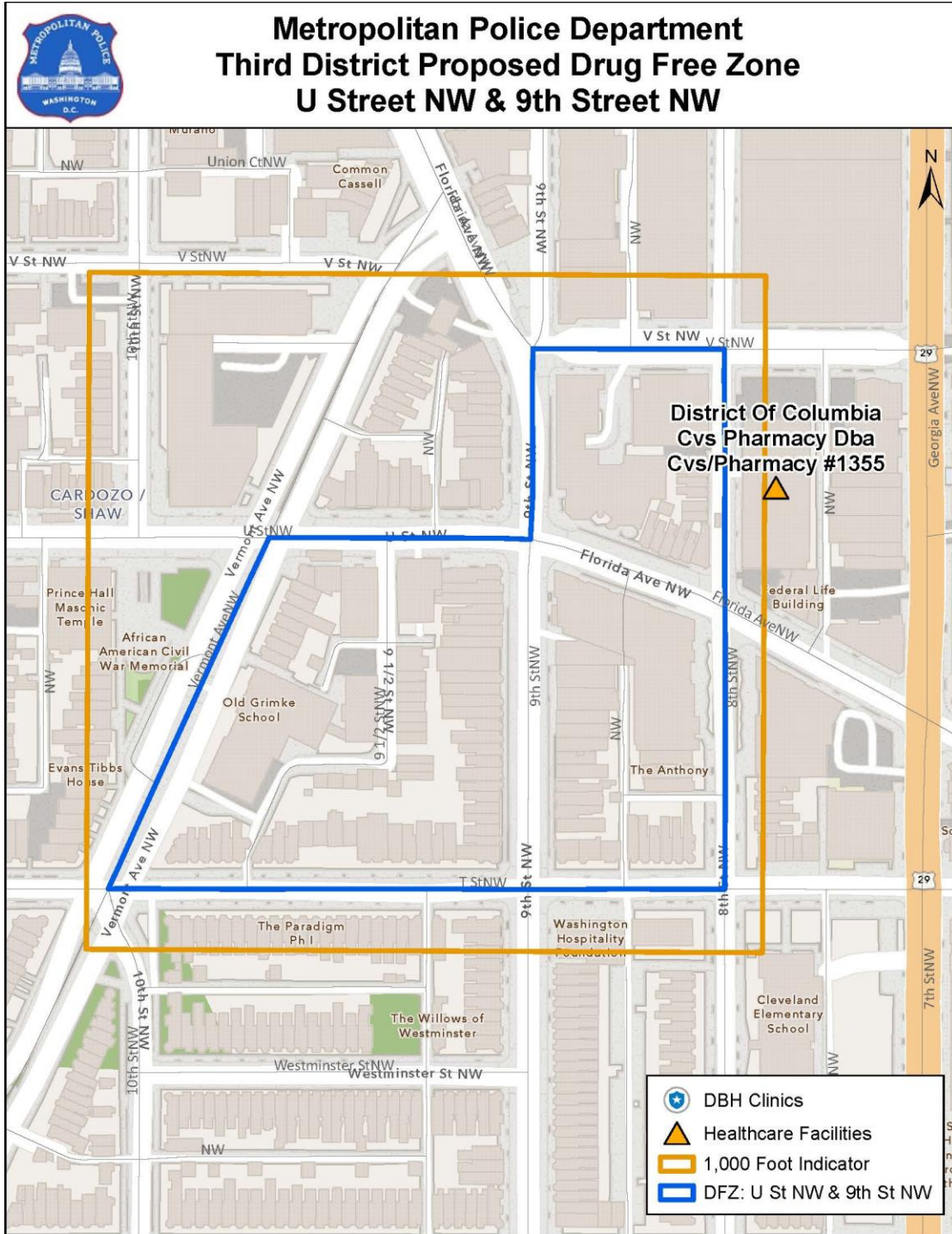
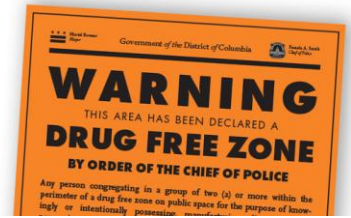
