E. NARRATIVE

On Monday June 1, 2020 at approximately 2130 hours, members of Special Operations Division, Domestic Security Operations and District CDU Platoons were holding police lines at 14th and Swann St NW and 15th and Swann Street NW. The police line at 14th and Swann St NW was preventing eastbound pedestrian traffic and the CDU line at 15th and Swann St NW was preventing westbound pedestrian traffic. There were approximately 100-200 individuals in the 1400 Block of Swann Street who were not free to leave the block and were under arrest for the mayor's curfew order.

On Monday June 1 2020 the mayor enacted a curfew effective at 1900 hours. Any individual outside of their residence after 1900 hours was subject to arrest. This group at Swann Street NW came from the Whitehouse area northbound on 14th Street NW. While downtown on 17th Street NW this group was given numerous warnings via LRAD (Long Range Acoustical Device) that if they were outside after 1900 hours they would be in violation of the mayor's curfew order and would be subject to arrest. Furthermore after 1900 hours they were advised via LRAD that they were in violation of the mayor's curfew order and would be arrested if they did not leave.

This group moved northbound on 14th Street and were destroying property while traveling to include spray painting buildings/cars, breaking windows, and setting a marked police car on fire.

When the group was in the 1400 Block of Swann Street NW they were continuously throwing rocks, bottles, and other projectiles at the MPD officers on the CDU line. Members of the group were jumping on top of vehicles causing damage to these vehicles and checking residence front doors to gain entry. At approximately 2138 hours there were multiple individuals in the block who began kicking the front doors of residences attempting to forcibly gain entry. At this time the CDU line at 15th and Swann St NW began moving the crowd in the eastbound direction.

The group continuously threw bottles and other projectiles at the police line while refusing to follow police commands to move back. Many individuals were assaulting Officers on the police line. OC spray was deployed to disperse the assaultive individuals and prevent further injuries and property damage. Multiple individuals were seen entering a residence on the north side of the block. There was a continuous flow of individuals running up the front steps and into this residence. MPD Officers reasonably believed that a possible Burglary was taking place. OC spray was deployed on the steps to prevent more individuals from entering the residence.

A tactical takedown was utilized on one defendant who was resisting arrest once placed in handcuffs. Mechanical force was utilized by CDU members when moving the riotous crowd eastbound in the block. The crowd was refusing commands to move back and were actively assaulting the officers on the police line. Multiple CDU members utilized their issued MPD riot batons and shields to move the crowd Eastbound along Swann Street, NW due to the crowd's violent behavior and refusal to follow the loud verbal commands to, "Move back."

On June 1, 2020, a knife, taser, and a can of spray paint were turned into the Third District after the arrest of the curfew violators.
