E. NARRATIVE

On 08/30/2020 at approximately 2200 hours a group of approximately 100 individuals marched from 16th & H St NW. The group was carrying bats, lacrosse sticks, umbrellas, helmets, gas masks, protective equipment and shields. MPD CDU units deployed rolling road closures to maintain the safety of the marchers and the community. The group began to discharge fireworks, bottle rockets and M80 (large explosives) at residences and directly at MPD members who were conducting road closures for the group. The group marched through residential and commercial neighborhoods spray painting and vandalizing public and private property, and setting off rockets, explosives and unknown munitions. At 2225 hours, Cruiser 50, declared the group no longer a First Amendment Assembly as there is criminal conduct by members of the marching group. All BWCs were activated. The group continued marching and targeted MPD by throwing fireworks, bottle rockets and improvised devices at them. As of 2300 hours, more fireworks were being deployed by the group in residential areas in violation of the Residential Tranquility Act. Trash cans and newspaper bins were knocked over in the area of 13th St NW and Q St NW. The group moved around Logan Circle, continuing to discharge fireworks at private residences in the area of Vermont Ave NW (south side) and Logan Circle, more specifically at 1341 Vermont for fireworks and 1339 Vermont Ave NW for smoke. At 2314 hours, Cruiser 50 received first complaint from citizen regarding the noise of the demonstration. At 2322 hours, based on actionable intelligence received, units at 16th St NW and H St NW were advised to have batons on belt and helmets ready. At 2327 hours, 1441 L St NW is tagged by the group with spray paint. As of 2328 hours, 1100 15th St NW is tagged by the group with spray paint. As of 2330 hours, another tag on the building at 1100 15th St NW. At of 2338 hours, the group spray painted the street in the area of 16th St NW between H and I Streets NW. At 2350 hours, rioters are standing on the barriers near the police line at 16th St NW and H St NW and throwing bottles and balloons filled with urine at officers in the chute at 16th St NW and H St NW. Shields and helmets were authorized and donned by MPD members on the line. Approximately 15 balloons filled with urine were thrown at officers at 16th St NW and H St NW and an individual was spitting on officers. At 2355 hours, a group of 5 are in front of the Hay-Adams taking items out of bags and began throwing more balloons, glass bottles, roman candles and explosive munitions at officers at the police line at 16th & H St NW. Munitions deployment was authorized by Inspector Glover. CDU lines were established to effect the arrest of the rioters.
