In accordance with the provisions of the Metropolitan Police Department's regulations, permission is hereby granted to Deena Katz to conduct a First Amendment Assembly on Saturday, March 24, 2018, 1100 hours (assembly time), 1700 hours (disbanding time), at 300 to 1100 blocks of Pennsylvania Ave NW, 300 to 600 blocks of Constitution Ave, NW, consisting of no more than 500,000 persons. You are permitted to possess hand held signs, banners, sound system, 4 generators, 90x56 stage, 48x24 press riser, 5,000 portable toilets, 5,000 feet of bike rack, and other production equipment to include 15 event trailers, 10 tour buses, 4 comfort trailers, and 4 scissor lifts.

A 20-foot-wide fire lane on the north side of Pennsylvania Avenue will be maintained for emergency vehicles at all times during this assembly. A 20-foot-wide fire lane on the south side of Constitution Avenue will be maintained for emergency vehicles.

A National Park Service permit is required for the use of the north and south Sidewalk areas in the 300 to 1100 blocks of Pennsylvania Avenue, NW.

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS

1. Applicant and all participants in the assembly herein authorized must comply with all the conditions of this assembly approval plan and applicable regulations and instructions issued by the Metropolitan Police Department.
2. The Metropolitan Police Department reserves the right to revoke this Assembly Plan Approval at any time, should the event present a clear and present danger to public health or safety, or if any conditions of this approval plan are violated by the applicant in the assembly herein authorized.
3. The applicant agrees that the assembly shall terminate at the expiration of the time specified herein; applicant assumes responsibility for the orderly disbanding of the assembly and for the orderly dispersal of all participants.
4. Applicant agrees that the area of the assembly shall be left in substantially the same condition as it was prior to the assembly authorized herein.
5. This plan approval is applicable only for the use of the area designated herein or any area as may hereafter be designated by the Chief, Metropolitan Police Department, or his representative.
6. In order to maintain public safety Applicant may be subject to District of Columbia safety inspections by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department, the Department of Health, and any other agencies deemed necessary by the MPD to ensure public safety.
7. It is understood that Deena Katz will be in charge of this assembly, and the person that the Metropolitan Police Department should contact in managing this event.
