a new one.**

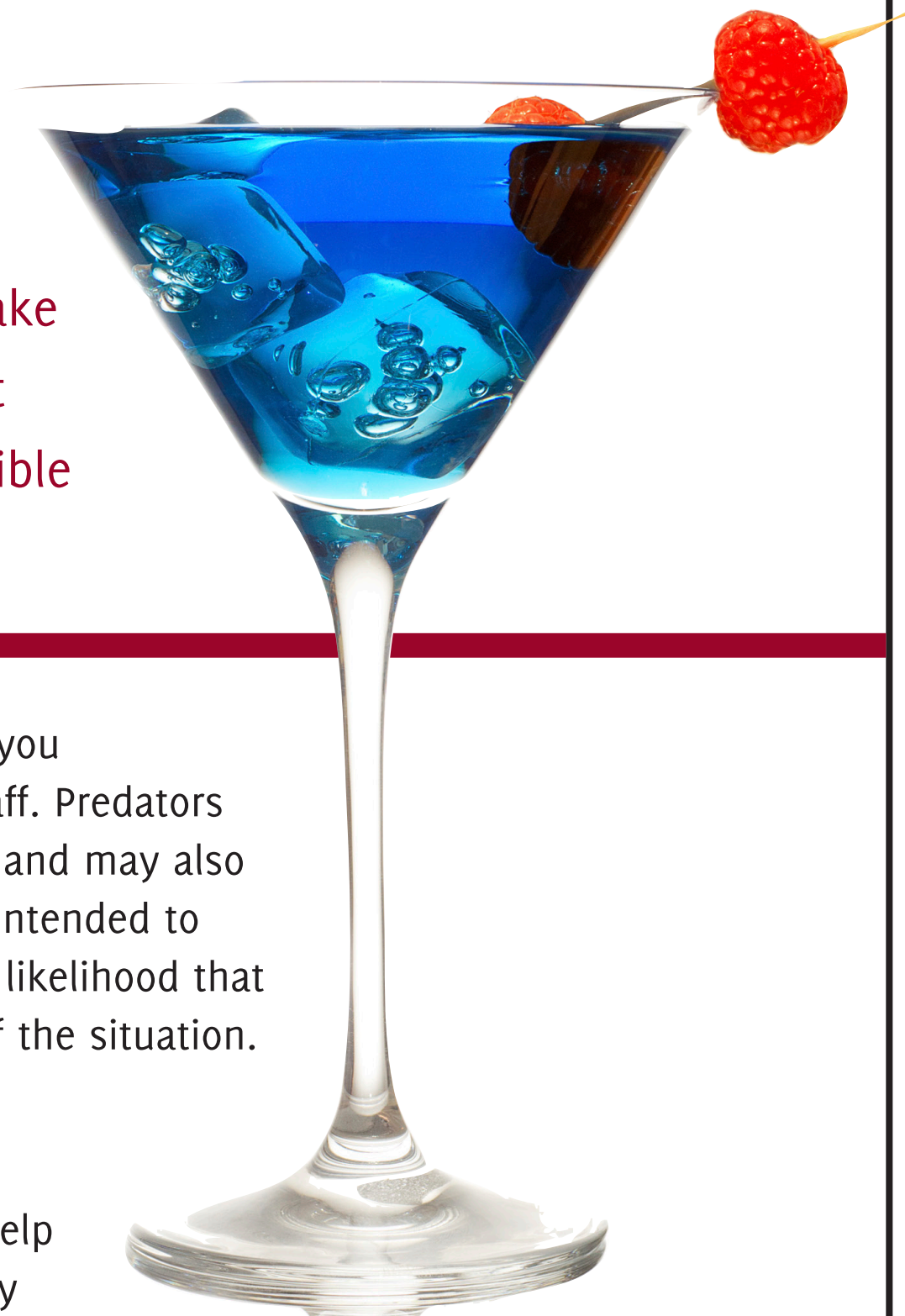
Don't leave your drink unattended. Reduce your risk and don't take chances. One in every eight adult women has been a victim of forcible rape sometime in her life.

If someone is bothering you or making you uncomfortable, tell a member of the staff. Predators and rapists may try to spike your drink and may also encourage you to drink more than you intended to reduce your ability to say "no" and the likelihood that you'll report a crime later on. Beware of the situation. If it doesn't feel right, it probably isn't.

If you think you've been drugged, get help immediately. Ask a trusted friend to stay with you and call **911**. And remember, you are never to blame for the actions of another person.
