DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT

On Saturday, May 12, 2007 at approximately 11:36 PM, Ms. **Brittney Hall** was sitting in a parked vehicle in the 1300 block of Taylor Street, NW, when shots were apparently fired at the vehicle. She was struck in the neck and transported to an area hospital. She died on Friday, May 18, 2007, as a result of her wounds. The Metropolitan Police Department seeks the public's assistance in gathering information regarding this homicide.
