DESCRIPTION

On Sunday, February 20, 2005, at approximately 11 pm, police were called to the 200 block of 62nd Street, NE, for the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, they discovered the victim, **Shawn Starling**, suffering from gunshot wounds. He was transported to an area hospital where he later died.
